



The six models in this fine set are accurate scale miniatures of outstanding modern cars, each beautifully enamelled in attractive colours.

The Packard "Super 8" Touring Sedan is a typical example of a modern American luxury car. It has an eight-cylinder 32.5 h.p. engine, and a four-door body capable of seating five passengers.

Another big roomy car is the Oldsmobile "Six" Sedan, which is a five-seater powered by a six-cylinder engine rated at 28.4 h.p.


One of the most distinctive American cars is the Lincoln "Zephyr" Coupé, which seats three passengers. It has a body of very advanced streamlined design and a V-type 12-cylinder engine of 36.3 h.p.

The Buick "Viceroy" Saloon also has a very distinctive appearance, due to the beautifully streamlined design of the front wings and the bonnet. Its engine has eight cylinders in line and is rated at 30.6 h.p. The gear lever is mounted on the steering column.

A good example of a seven-seater car of the sedan type is the Chrysler "Royal." A safety all-steel body with a seamless top is fitted, and the six-cylinder engine is rated at 27.34 h.p.

The attractively streamlined Studebaker "State Commander" Coupé is powered by a six-cylinder engine of 26.35 h.p. The gear-box is fitted with remote control from a lever on the steering column. The body is of one-piece seamless steel construction.







The Hawker "Hurricane" is a recent type of high-speed single-seater fighter that is extensively used by the Royal Air Force. It is fitted with a Rolls-Royce "Merlin" engine and can attain a speed of 335 m.p.h. at 17,500 ft. It takes only 9 minutes to climb to a height of 20,000 ft.

The "Hurricane" is very heavily armed, having eight machine guns, four inside each wing, all firing outside the radius of the airscrew.

MAYO COMPOSITE AIRCRAFT

The Composite Aircraft was invented by Major R. H. Mayo and built by Short Bros. (Rochester and Bedford) Ltd., to the order of the Air Ministry for experimental flights by Imperial Airways. The object of this aircraft is to solve the problem of getting a heavily loaded long-range machine into the air, by lifting it on the back of a larger machine from which it takes off, the lifting machine then returning to its base.

Among the fine flights achieved by the upper component, the seaplane "Mercury." after being launched in this way, are the following: July 1938, Foynes, Eire, to Montreal and New York, 3,240 miles; October 1938, Dundee to the Orange River, South Africa, 6,045 miles. "Mercury" has a top speed of 212 m.p.h.
