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DINKY BUILDER

Instructions

Dinky Builder plates are hinged on all sides, with intervening spaces, so that when two are placed side by side the hinged part of one plate fits into the corresponding space in the other. A rod can be pushed through the complete hinge, and in this manner any number of plates can be built up to form various geometrical shapes.

The simplest method of connecting a series of plates together to construct a model is first to lay out the necessary parts, hinges upward, on a flat surface, in the positions they will occupy in the completed model. (See Fig. 2.) The rods are then inserted, the special tool supplied with the Outfits being used to push them in. (See Fig. 1.)



It is sometimes necessary to bring the hinges of two separate plates into line before the rod is inserted. In such cases the task of lining up will be greatly simplified by pushing the tool through the hinges so that they are brought into line, and then withdrawing it.

The tool must be used when disassembling the models. For this purpose it is pushed into the hinge forming the constructional connection, so that the rod is forced out. In this manner a model can be taken to pieces in a very short time.






Where a rod is inserted in the hinges of one plate only, it may occasionally be found that the rod is not gripped quite firmly enough to hold it in position. This may be easily adjusted by inserting the rod in the first hinge of the plate and gently bending this *very slightly* out of line with the other hinges (see Fig. 3). Then, when the rod is once more pushed through all the hinges, it will be held securely.









