- 1. Articles must be original (that is they must not be copied from Juneero Design Sheets already published) and must be suitable for making up with Juneero Tools and Materials only. Otherwise there are no restrictions upon the nature of the designs suggested, and both simple and advanced designs will stand an equal chance.
- 2. Actual models must be sent, although they need not be highly finished. It is unnecessary to send drawings as these will be produced by our own Design Department.
- 3. There are two Sections—Juniors up to 16 years and Seniors 16 years and over, and all entries will be adjudicated in their respective class. Prizes of £2 2s. Od., £1 1s. Od., 10s. 6d. and Consolation Awards for winning designs.
- 4. All models should be securely packed and protected against damage in the post. They should be addressed to:
