

Rod and a full stop for a Bolt hole. However there may be one other pair. The quantities given for the 5 pairs of PNs include 4 each for 2 of them. One, the Type (a) in Fig.4, is credible but there look to be more than 4 pairs for the Types (b)-(e), and in that case what is the other '4 off each' pair?

**The Wheels**. 5 different types can be seen in the bottom end compartments. At the left end 2 sizes of 'aluminium' Pulleys which scale very roughly at  $3\frac{1}{2}$  & 5cm Ø. At the right end (Fig.5) a Tyred Pulley about 3cm Ø over the Tyre, a flanged Railway Wheel  $2\frac{1}{4}$ cm Ø, and a Pulley of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ cm Ø. If all are genuine they could correspond to the 5 PNs shown for these 2 compartments on the lid.

**Other Parts** Just the cheeseheaded Bolts which hold the Clamps together, a few longer ones, and the Formed Rods in Fig.5. **The Models** The models on 2 pages of the manual (Fig.6) are a Scooter, Weighing

Scales, a Tricycle Delivery Cart, an Aeroplane Hanger, & a House. Questions come to mind – for instance how are the Trike's front wheels retained on their axles, but the photo is too blurry to see.
